ORDINANCE NO. 25-04

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE OPIOID SETTLEMENT RESTRICTED FUND TO BUDGET CLASSIFICATION PERSONAL SERVICES 411 (\$35,000.00)

WHEREAS, the City of Greenwood ("City") has received funds as a participant in the settlement of a national multi-district litigation case against certain opioid manufacturers, the Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund, which allows settlement funds to be used to pay salaries or wages of employees who provide assistance or services to persons who have been adversely impacted by opioid addiction;

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended the addition of a part-time Mobile Integrated Health Coordinator position in the Fire Department to provide support to community members who receive health-related emergency services, including persons adversely impacted by opioid addiction, and to facilitate community resources for those persons;

WHEREAS, the wages of the Mobile Integrated Health Coordinator position shall be funded by the Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund, and the Fire Chief advises that funds are needed to cover the wages of the position for 2025 in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$35,000.00);

WHEREAS, the City Controller has determined that the Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund has a sufficient balance available to fund the part-time Mobile Integrated Health Coordinator position, and requests an appropriation from the Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund to budget classification Personal Services 411- Salaries and Wages, to cover the compensation of the position for 2025 in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$35,000.00);

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to make the appropriation and shall hold a public hearing in accordance with law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, INDIANA, THAT:


Section 1. For the expenses of the City of Greenwood, the following sum of money is hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the fund herein named and for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws governing the same:

Personal Services – 411 Salaries and Wages	\$35,000.00

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
